## CAFÉ ART - CREATIVE SENSORY ART

CAFÉ ART is a typical expression of the partnership between SAWYERS CHURCH and FRONTLINE. The concept is to give the opportunity to participants to enjoy the art-making process. It is a sensory exercise aimed at promoting motor and visual stimulation. It does not matter if the final result is a simple line on paper or a complete painting. It is not about completion or competition but fun and what everyone is able to create individually or with the interaction and help of their carer/social worker.

We welcome people with a learning disability. Participants are able to create artworks through simple techniques such as collage, dabbing, mixing colours, drawing and painting.



Although there is always a lesson prepared in advance, participants are allowed and motivated to be spontaneous. They can create from their own ideas with the materials available on the day.

The art session is run alongside CROWN CAFÉ where you can buy a delicious brunch, cakes, drinks and snacks, you can enjoy socialising with friends and make it a fun day!

CAFÉ ART happens during school term times.
